Discussion on future actions and funding

- Need for the network is clear
 - Small separate groups exists which are working for similar tasks and aims (i.e. groups under IASC Cryosphere WG and SCAR, Arctic Snow Network and national activities) → networking between the groups would be beneficial
 - Existing HarmoSnow network is already comprehensive and should be sustained (e.g. email lists)
 - o Continuation is secured if funding could be found
 - Search funding to get also Canada and USA more involved
 - Few global funding available
- Actions for future harmonization
 - o Training is one of the most effective ways for harmonization of snow measurements
 - APECS exists for early career scientists
 - Snow Science Winter School is important for education of early career scientist
 - Annual activity
 - Funded by FMI, SLF and several other organizations (e.g. IACS, IASC, SCAR, EGU) including HarmoSnow
 - Training of more experienced scientist
 - Field training beneficial e.g. for remote sensing and modelling focused people
 - Possibility to organize a workshop and field training together
 - Could be organized i.e. every three years
 - Usually national training and workshop activities already exists
 - Information could be shared to national networks from European wide training by participants
- Separate HarmoSnow workshop or combined with some larger conference (i.e. EGU)
 - Background: Western / Eastern Snow Conference is organized regularly in America → similar meeting does not exist in Europe
 - Aiming to sustainable event

- o Combines different interests: remote sensing, hydrology etc.
- \circ Organization requires funding and time \rightarrow that should be solved first
- Future funding possibilities
 - Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions, Initial Training Networks (ITN)
